## **Self Examination (Step 1)**

# **Understanding Your Soil Types (Step 2)**

**Matthew 13:3-9** - <sup>3</sup>And He spoke many things to them in parables, saying, "Behold, the sower went out to sow; <sup>4</sup> and as he sowed, some *seeds* fell beside the road, and the birds came and ate them up. <sup>5</sup>Others fell on the rocky places, where they did not have much soil; and immediately they sprang up, because they had no depth of soil. <sup>6</sup> But when the sun had risen, they were scorched; and because they had no root, they withered away. <sup>7</sup>Others fell <sup>[b]</sup> among the thorns, and the thorns came up and choked them out. <sup>8</sup> And others fell on the good soil and \*yielded a crop, some a hundredfold, some sixty, and some thirty. <sup>9</sup> He who has ears, <sup>[c]</sup>let him hear."

**Matthew 13:18-23 -** "Hear then the parable of the sower. <sup>19</sup> When anyone hears the <sup>[i]</sup> word of the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil *one* comes and snatches away what has been sown in his heart. This is the one on whom seed was sown beside the road. <sup>20</sup> The one on whom seed was sown on the rocky places, this is the man who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; <sup>21</sup> yet he has

no *firm* root in himself, but is *only* temporary, and when affliction or persecution arises because of the <sup>[]</sup>word, immediately he <sup>[]</sup>falls away. <sup>22</sup> And the one on whom seed was sown among the thorns, this is the man who hears the word, and the worry of the <sup>[]</sup>world and the deceitfulness of wealth choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful. <sup>23</sup> And the one on whom seed was sown on the good soil, this is the man who hears the word and understands it; who indeed bears fruit and brings forth, some a hundredfold, some sixty, and some thirty."

#### Matthew 13:1-23

4 Types of Soil

- Road (no understanding)
- **Rocky** (no firm root)
- **Thorny** (worry of the world & deceitfulness of wealth)
- Good Soil (hears and understands)

# **Controlling Your Emotions (Step 3)**
